## **Jacksonville University Club Sport Classification System**

Club must satisfy the following criteria to obtain and retain club sport status.

Please record the appropriate events on Google Forms.

- 1. Club must participate and represent Jacksonville University for at least 1 event, not including a national event.
  - The event can be local
  - Jacksonville University can host the event
  - A club can travel for the event
- 2. Club must participate in Jacksonville University's Dolphin Dash Annual Giving Challenge.
- 3. Club must participate in community or campus service projects with a minimum of 50 total service hours, in at least 1 distinct event.
  - At least five club members must participate toward the 50 hours
  - A club member may not attend an event as a representative of 2 separate clubs
  - If 10 people worked for 3 hours = 30 hours
- 4. Club members must attend a NCAA contest, Varsity contest, club sport event, Fine Arts event, or Diversity & Inclusion event as spectators abiding by the following regulations:
  - 5 members must attend 2 varsity contests/club sport events
  - Must be in attendance for entire game/event or at least 2 hours to receive credit
  - A club member may not attend an event as a representative of 2 separate clubs
  - Must be 2 distinct varsity contests or club sports (men's & women's soccer are considered the same sport and will only count once)
  - Must take a picture of everyone there to receive credit
- 5. Club must have an active social media presence on at least one of the following outlets:
  - Instagram, Facebook, Twitter
  - Clubs must post at least once a week
